ON CAMPUS INTERNSHIPS

The 1-credit prerequisite course, *GLAS 105*, prepares you to intern with departments at UIC that support Asian American Pacific Islander (AAPI) students. The course focuses on AAPI college student experiences and career development skills building, such as strengthening resumes, interviewing, and public speaking. Placements will be offered to students who enroll in the course, and internships begin the semester after. Set your hours and schedule with your internship site and present your work at an annual symposium!

OFF CAMPUS INTERNSHIPS

This 3-credit prerequisite course, *GLAS 250*, prepares you to intern with community-based organizations in the Chicago area related to civil rights, social services, or arts and culture in Asian American and Pacific Islander communities. Set your hours and schedule with your internship site and receive credit while gaining valuable work and field experience. Present your work at an annual symposium to highlight student-community partnerships while showcasing your internship project. Student internship placements will be announced in Fall 2017.
